

Cross-Country Ski Trails

Meadow Trail (yellow) 1.5 mi / 2.4 km - Skate/Classic Skiing
Easy, mostly open

Vahtera Trail (orange) 2.0 mi / 3.2 km - Classic Skiing
Moderate, some hills, forested

Takesson Trail (green) 2.5 mi / 4.0 km - Classic Skiing
Moderate, forested, river views

Pipeline Trail (blue) 4.6 mi / 7.4 km - Skate/Classic Skiing
Moderate, some hills, forested, open

NO Hiking, snowshoeing and pets on ski trails: To keep ski trails in the best condition possible, once trails are snow-covered, hiking, snowshoeing, pets and other uses are not permitted on the groomed ski trails.

Hiking / Snowshoe Trails

Winter Waterfall Trail (purple) 1.0 mi / 1.6 km - Groomed
Easy, forested, waterfall views (NO pets allowed)

Red Granite (red) 2.5 mi / 4.0 km - Groomed
Moderate, some hills, forested, river views (pets allowed)

Doughboy's Trail (brown) 1.7 mi / 2.7 km
Moderate, Not maintained during winter, stairs (NO pets allowed)

CCC 692 Trail (gray) 1.0 mi / 1.6 km
Moderate, Not maintained during winter, stairs (NO pets allowed)

Little Creek Trail (black) 0.8 mi / 1.3 km
Moderate, Not maintained during winter (pets allowed)

Trails north of the Bad and Tyler Forks rivers (North Country, Doughboy's, CCC 692 and Little Creek trails) are open but are not maintained for winter use. Please use caution.

Groomed hiking/snowshoe trails include the Winter Waterfall Trail (purple) and the Red Granite Falls (red) Trails.
