Resolution in Support of a Wisconsin State Park System Trail Crew

Whereas the Wisconsin State Park System expects to spend \$2,250,000 on current trail repair projects and even more on future projects,

And Whereas well-built, sustainable trails offer greater user enjoyment, greater resource protection, less maintenance, and less state dollars over the long term,

And Whereas constructing and rehabilitating or rerouting trails to be sustainable is a significant undertaking that requires specific skills, experience, and equipment,

And Whereas the Recreational Trails Program provides funds to States to develop and maintain recreational trails,

And Whereas other States successfully use Recreational Trails Program funds to fund Trail Crews,

Therefore be it resolved that the State Trails Council supports the development of a Trail Crew utilizing Recreational Trails Program funding.
