Pet Friendly Hiking Trails

Pets are allowed **on-leash** on the trails listed below.

- Butler Lake Trail Loop (3.1 miles)
- Greenbush Hiking Trail System (total of 9 miles) No hiking or pets when snow is present on ski trails.
- Ice Age National Scenic Trail (33 miles)
 See Northern Unit map for access points for this linear trail.
 Trail distances available at State Forest offices.
- New Fane Hiking Trail System (total of 5.5 miles)
 No hiking or pets when snow is present on ski trails.
- Parnell Tower Trail Loop (3.5 miles)
- Zillmer Hiking Trail System (total of 8 miles)
 No hiking or pets when snow is present on ski trails.

Pets are prohibited on Parnell Tower, in Forest Offices, and on marked nature trails. These include Long Lake's Summit Trail, Ice Age Visitor Center's Moraine Trail and Spruce Lake Bog Boardwalk.

No person may allow his or her dog, cat or other pet to interfere in any manner with the enjoyment of the area by others.

Pet Picnic Areas

There are designated pet picnic areas located at the Mauthe Lake and Long Lake Recreation Areas. Please clean up after your pet. Thank you!

Pets are prohibited on swimming beaches and adjacent picnic areas.

Pet Water Access

Pets may access the water at the Mauthe Lake and Long Lake boat launches. However, to minimize conflicts, pets are not allowed in these areas when boats are being loaded and unloaded.

Other less-congested areas to consider are the Butler Lake and Lake Seven boat launches. See forest staff for directions.

Pets must always remain on-leash.
